## FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICTS JOINT JOB ANNOUNCEMENT **AMENDED**

# ***FIRE ENGINEER***

The Placer Hills, Newcastle and Penryn Fire Districts are holding an open test to **fill vacancies at both Placer Hills and Penryn** and to create an eligibility list for the position of Engineer for all 3 districts. This list will be good for one year. All 3 departments operate on the 48-96 shift schedule.

### POSITION

The engineer, under the supervision of Company Officers, Captains and Chief Officers, operates all apparatus in the fire districts.

### THE APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Application review: all applicants must submit an application and resume by the filing date.
2. Assessment center: Applicants will be tested on engineering skills on the training ground.
3. Written test: This will consist of multi-choice questions.
4. Oral interview: The interview panel will assess the candidates.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Applicants must score 70% and above on each section of the test and score 75% or above on the total.
2. Paramedic applicants may be given priority, depending on the needs of the department.
3. Applicants will have an opportunity to familiarize and practice on the departments' apparatus prior to the testing date.
4. Applicants who pass all phases of the process may have a Chief's interview as positions become available.
5. Applicants who pass the Chief's interview must successfully pass a background investigation and medical evaluation.
